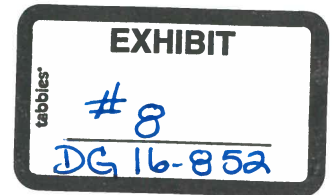

Dartmouth College (the "College") has been contacted by the Town of Hanover and the City of Lebanon regarding the above-captioned proceeding. My understanding is that a formal proceeding is underway that will lead to a hearing on September 7, 2017, and that discovery is ongoing. It has been brought to my attention that a potential question in the proceeding may involve the College's future plans for energy procurement. Please be advised that, while the College takes no position on the merits of the request by Liberty Utilities, the College does not currently have any plans to procure natural gas by pipeline for the campus. In fact, the College has adopted a Sustainability Roadmap that focuses on renewable resources.
