
Dear Ms. Howland,

I oppose the fracked-gas Lebanon/Hanover pipeline. This is the Liberty Utilities proposal, docket # DG 16-852.

Natural gas is far more harmful to the environment than propane or clean renewables. I cannot support the damage done to watersheds and sand reserves through fracking, or the harm to our atmosphere from methane leaks. I also object strongly to more traffic in West Lebanon. None of this is necessary.

I hope the PUC will do the right thing and turn down Liberty's bad idea. We do not want fracked natural gas in the Upper Valley.
