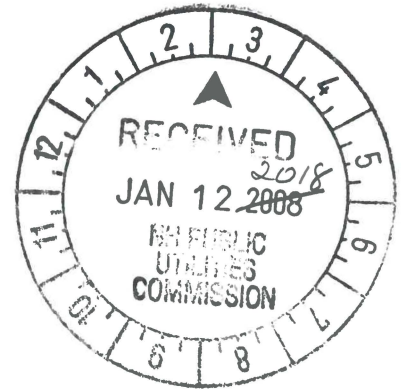

Re: DE 17-136 – 2018-2020 New Hampshire Statewide Energy Efficiency Plan

Dear Director Howland:

On January 2, 2018, the Commission issued Order No. 26,095 in the above docket approving a settlement agreement relating to the implementation of an Energy Efficiency Resource Standard (“EERS”) in New Hampshire in 2018. That Order approved a modified version of the EERS plan submitted by New Hampshire Electric and Natural Gas Utilities: Liberty Utilities (Granite State Electric) Corp. d/b/a Liberty Utilities; New Hampshire Electric Cooperative, Inc.; Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy; Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. (UES); Liberty Utilities (EnergyNorth Natural Gas) Corp d/b/a Liberty Utilities; and Northern Utilities, Inc. (Northern) (collectively, the “NH Utilities”) on September 1, 2017. As part of the Order, the Commission required the NH Utilities to file an updated version of the EERS plan reflecting the changes necessitated by the settlement agreement within 15 days of the date of the Order.

In line with the Commission’s requirement, enclosed for filing is an updated version of the EERS plan reflecting the changes required under the settlement agreement. For ease of reference, any pages where changes were required by the settlement agreement are marked with a letter “R” to designate that they have been revised.
