RE: DE 17-136 - NHSaves Energy Efficiency Programs Fourth Quarter 2019 Report

Dear Director Howland:

Enclosed for filing with the Commission is the revised Second Quarter 2020 Report for the NHSaves Energy Efficiency Programs containing results for all the electric and natural gas utilities.

The revisions made include:

- Eversource Actual C&I and Municipal savings were erroneously reported as MWh instead of kWh (impacts C&I savings to date – See tab 12) This adjustment increases reported kWh savings from Eversource C&I and Municipal throughout report.
- Large C&I Goals had erroneously picked up Small C&I savings as well (impacts large C&I goals – See tab 12) The goal is now reduced to the correct amount, corresponding % to goal calculations increase.
- Until HERs were not incorporated into the annual or lifetime kWh goals (impacts Unutil goals – See tab 7) The goal is now increased to correct amount, corresponding % to goal calculations decrease.
- Unutil and Liberty reporting actual Home Energy Report savings with a 1-year measure life. Through review with the EM&V working group the determination has been made to move to a 1 -year measure life for HER for the 2021-2023 Plan. In order to effectively make that change, Unutil and Liberty need to stop claiming persistence savings from HER in 2020. They cannot claim both a multi-year measure life in 2020 *and* a 1-year measure-life in 2021, so the claimed savings for 2020 are being adjusted
