DW 17-165 Abenaki Water Company – Rosebrook Rate Case

Dear Ms. Howland:

On May 1, 2018, at the technical session / settlement conference in DW 17-165, Mr. Vaughan provided an overview of the pressure problems / solutions at Rosebrook. He indicated that the Company would prepare a presentation of the pressure reduction project and provide an estimate of the costs and the related revenue requirement associated with phase one. As such, attached is the AWC: Rosebrook System Pressure Reduction presentation, which identifies pressure issues, goals and pressure reduction project costs and phasing.

Also, attached are SPS 5-10, which show an estimated costs of phase one to be \$940,000 and an increase in the revenue requirement of \$77,097, an approximate 28% increase over 2017 operating revenues. Please note the proposed step increase for 2018 additions to plant in the original filing (See Step Increase, Page 3 of 4) included an estimated \$170,000 of the phase one costs.

In addition, attached are a redline version of revised terms and conditions related to pressure at Rosebrook including a new attachment, Attachment B, to the revised tariff which illustrates in detail the location and boundaries of common areas.
