1	PROCEEDING
2	CHAIRMAN HONIGBERG: We're here this
3	morning in Docket DW 17-176, which is a
4	Petition to Transfer the Utility Assets and
5	Franchise of Wildwood Water Company to Lakes
6	Region Water Company. It's a prehearing
7	conference. We have a technical session
8	scheduled afterwards.
9	Let's take appearances.
10	MR. RICHARDSON: Good morning, Mr.
11	Chairman. Justin Richardson, of Upton &
12	Hatfield, here on behalf of Lakes Region Water
13	Company. With me here at counsel's table, I
14	have Leah Valladares, who is the Company's
15	Utility Manager. And behind me is Mr. Burnham
16	Quint, who is the current owner of the Wildwood
17	water system.
18	MR. KREIS: Good morning,
19	Commissioners. I'm D. Maurice Kreis, the
20	Consumer Advocate. My job is to represent the
21	interest of residential utility customers,
22	including the customers of both of these
23	utilities.
24	MR. SPEIDEL: Good morning,

1 Commissioners. Alexander Speidel, representing the Staff of the Commission. And I have with 2 3 me Mark Naylor, the Director of the Water Division; Jayson Laflamme, Utility Analyst; and 4 Robyn Descoteau, Utility Analyst. 5 6 Thank you. 7 CHAIRMAN HONIGBERG: I have not seen any petitions to intervene. Is anyone aware of 8 9 any intervenors in this? 10 All right. I see a lot of shaking 11 heads. 12 MR. RICHARDSON: No. 13 CHAIRMAN HONIGBERG: Anything we need 14 to do before we hear initial positions of the 15 parties? 16 [No verbal response.] 17 CHAIRMAN HONIGBERG: All right. Mr. Richardson, why don't you start us off. 18 19 MR. RICHARDSON: Sure. This is a 20 relatively straightforward case. It's a good 21 project, we think. The Company is buying --22 Lakes Region is buying the assets for \$25,000, 23 which is less than rate base. We've had to 24 incur some transaction costs to get everything  $\{DW \ 17-176\}$  [Prehearing conference]  $\{01-23-18\}$ 

1 up to speed. We have -- I think this is going to 2 3 be a very positive thing from a customer perspective. Lakes Region has a team of 4 certified operators. Right now, the system is 5 6 being operated by Mr. Quint and an outside 7 contractor F.X. Lyons. The system's, you know, got -- it's 8 in compliance, it's not in risk of immediate 9 10 failure, but it has some needs that are on the 11 horizon that we'll discuss with Staff during 12 the technical session. 13 We think, you know, we're expecting 14 to reach a settlement agreement for the 15 transfer, and we don't expect any major issues 16 to occur. 17 CHAIRMAN HONIGBERG: Mr. Kreis. 18 MR. KREIS: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. 19 The OCA entered an appearance in this case, I 20 would say, prophylactically. And I have no reason to suppose that the manner in which Mr. 21 Richardson just characterized the case is 22 23 incorrect. And I think there's every reason to 24 expect that we would become a signatory to a  $\{DW \ 17-176\}$  [Prehearing conference]  $\{01-23-18\}$ 

1	settlement agreement in relatively short order
2	and allow this transaction to go forward.
3	CHAIRMAN HONIGBERG: Mr. Speidel.
4	MR. SPEIDEL: Thank you, Mr.
5	Chairman. Staff would echo the comments of the
6	other two parties, insofar as we hope that this
7	can be handled relatively expeditiously. We
8	have developed a draft procedural schedule that
9	we will propose to the OCA and to the
10	Petitioner, where this matter will terminate,
11	in all likelihood, by the end of March.
12	Lakes Region is a smaller, perhaps of
13	intermediate size at this point, water company,
14	based largely on the north shore of the Lake
15	Winnipesaukee Region. So, this system, in the
16	southern part of the White Mountains Region, or
17	the northern part of the Lakes Region,
18	depending on how you look at it, in the Town of
19	Albany, it would be a good fit for the Lakes
20	Region system, in terms of the ability to
21	service the customers there, and to provide a
22	little bit more of a consolidated structure for
23	the servicing of their needs than what they
24	might have right now.

1 So, we do look forward to looking -we look forward to working with the OCA and the 2 Petitioner in reviewing this. 3 4 Thank you. Thank you. 5 CHAIRMAN HONIGBERG: Yes. 6 Mr. Speidel, you actually answered both of the 7 questions that I had. Off the record. 8 [Brief off-the-record discussion 9 ensued.] 10 CHAIRMAN HONIGBERG: So, we'll go 11 back on the record. 12 All right. If there's nothing else 13 we need to do, we will leave you to your 14 technical session and adjourn the prehearing 15 conference. Thank you. 16 (Whereupon the prehearing 17 conference was adjourned at 18 10:11 a.m., and a technical 19 session was held immediately 20 thereafter.) 21 22 23 24
