Re: DE 17-189; Liberty Utilities (Granite State Electric) Corp. d/b/a Liberty
Petition to Approve Battery Storage Pilot Program

Per the Settlement Agreement approved in Order No. 26,209 in this docket dated January 18, 2019, the Company is to file quarterly reports 45 days after the end of a quarter detailing Phase 1 program data and an initial report and analysis on Phase 1. Further, the Company agreed that it would provide a preliminary eighteen-month Phase 1 report to the Department of Energy 45 days after the end of Phase 1 (determined to be August 31, 2022, per Order No. 26,364) with a final initial analysis on Phase 1 by November 29, 2022. The Company provided the preliminary eighteen-month Phase 1 report to the DOE on October 17, 2022, detailing Q3 2022 program data along with other preliminary information on the pilot. The Company will be filing the full analysis of Phase 1, including Q3 2022, per the Settlement Agreement on November 29, 2022. The Company believes the initial analysis on Phase 1 closes out the Phase 1 quarterly program data reporting requirement.
