Dear Public Utilities Commissioners,

I would like to ask you to oppose the Granite Bridge pipeline and tank. I recently heard that Liberty Utilities plans to sell gas from Granite Bridge to an electricity producer in Londonderry (ironically named Granite Ridge). For the past 11 months, Liberty Utilities has been telling us we need the Granite Bridge pipeline so we can heat our homes. It's unacceptable for Liberty Utilities to have misled us for this long but now that we know they want to use this gas to generate electricity it seems obvious that we should deny the pipeline. Utilizing solar and wind instead of natural gas would not only be more sustainable, it would also be better for New Hampshire's economy. Local energy like wind and solar will create long-term jobs in our state and keep the money we spend on energy in New Hampshire. Please stop Granite Bridge.

If not STOP, please at least SLOW DOWN the process and be sure to gather local input before making your decisions. I live less than 1.5miles from the tank site as the crow flies.
