

A contract-expiration notice will be sent to you at least thirty (45) days prior to the end of your Term. If you fail to take action to ensure the continued receipt of fixed rate retail energy service upon the contract's expiration, you will automatically continue to be served by Mega Energy pursuant to a variable rate product on a month-to-month basis unless you select another product or electric supplier.

Please consult your Utility's tariffs for information regarding late fees on delinquent payments, termination of service for non-payment, security deposits, payment arrangement plans, and other payment and credit terms. If you fail to take action to ensure the continued receipt of fixed rate retail energy service upon the contract's expiration, you will automatically continue to be served by Mega Energy pursuant to a variable rate product on a month-to-month basis unless you select another product or electric supplier.

Variable Rate Plan — A month-to-month plan rate may vary each month according to market conditions. This product shall commence for a one (1) month term ("Initial Term").
