Enclosed for filing on behalf of CleanChoice Energy, Inc. ("CleanChoice") is a renewal application for a Competitive Electric Power Supplier License. 

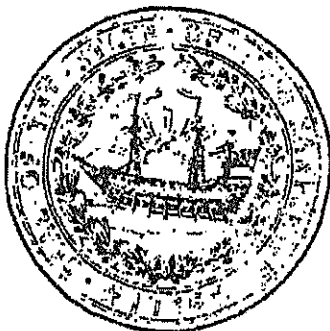

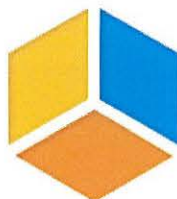

In May of 2015, CleanChoice Energy, Inc. (f/k/a Ethical Electric, Inc.) signed an Assurance of Voluntary Compliance (“AVC”) in response to a request of the Pennsylvania Attorney General (“PA AG”). In the AVC, Ethical Electric admitted no wrongdoing, but agreed to make changes to marketing and operational practices and procedures. Ethical Electric paid no fines, nor paid any restitution to customers. In August of 2016, CleanChoice (f/k/a Ethical Electric) signed an AVC in response to a request of the Illinois Attorney General (“IL AG”). In this AVC, Ethical Electric admitted no wrongdoing, but agreed to make changes to marketing and operational practice and procedures, to provide a credit of approximately \$10.00 to current and former customers, and to offer any current and former customers the opportunity to request an additional refund if the customer felt misled by certain marketing claims.
