Dear Director Howland:

In Order No. 26,220, issued on February 8, 2018, granting franchise authority to Northern Utilities, Inc. ("Northern" or "Company") to operate in the Town of Epping, the Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") required that Northern "develop and file a detailed cost summary within 60 days after the in-service date of Phase 1 and Phase 2 line extensions, with a variance analysis of those costs compared to the cost projections used in Exhibit 8." Order No. 26,220 at 12.

The first meter in Phase 2 of the project was set on May 26, 2021. Accordingly, and in compliance with the Order, enclosed is a schedule showing the original estimated cost by category, the actual cost, the variance amount, and a brief explanation of the variance.
