KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS THAT WE, UGI Energy Services, LLC as Principal, and Liberty Mutual Insurance Company, a corporation duly organized and doing business under and by the virtue of the laws of the State of Massachusetts, and duly licensed for the purpose of making, guaranteeing or becoming sole surety upon bonds or undertakings required or authorized by the laws of the said State, as Surety, are held and firmly bound unto New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Hereinafter called the Obligee) in the sum of Three Hundred Fifty Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$350,000.00) for the payment whereof well and truly to be made we and each of us bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.

THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION IS SUCH that, whereas, the above bounden PRINCIPAL has made application for a license to the Obligee to offer, render, furnish or supply natural gas services to the public.

NOW THEREFORE, the Principal must act in accordance with Section PUC 3000 of the New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules, to assure compliance with applicable provisions of PUC 3003.03 Reporting and Financial Requirements of Competitive Natural Gas Suppliers, and the laws, rules and regulations of the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission applicable to a competitive natural gas supplier under PUC 3000.

NOW THEREFORE, if the Principal shall during the period commencing on the effective date, faithfully observe and honestly comply with such rules, regulations and statutes that are applicable to a Competitive Natural Gas Supplier licensed in the State of New Hampshire and deliver natural gas at retail in accordance with contracts, agreements and arrangements, then this obligation shall become void and of no effect.

PROVIDED, HOWEVER,

1. The effective date of this bond is from 10/31/2018 to 3/30/2024. Bond cannot be cancelled less than one year after the anticipated date of approval. Neither non-renewal by the Surety, nor failure, nor inability of the Principal to file a replacement bond shall constitute a loss to the Obligee recoverable under this bond.
2. In the event of default by the Principal, the Surety shall be liable only for damages incurred by Obligee up to termination date of this bond.
3. No claim shall be had or maintained against the Surety on this instrument unless such be brought or instituted and no suit shall be maintained against the Surety unless it be brought within three (3) months from the termination or expiration date of this bond.
4. If any conflict or inconsistency exists between the Surety's obligations or undertakings as described in this bond and as described in the underlying document, then the terms of this bond shall prevail.
5. The aggregate liability of the Surety is limited to the penal sum stated herein regardless of the number or amount of claims brought against this bond and regardless of the number of years this bond remains in force.

6. This bond shall not bind the Surety unless the bond is accepted by the Obligee. If the Obligee objects to any language contained herein, the Obligee shall return this bond, certified mail or express courier, to the Surety at its address at:

This Power of Attorney is made and executed pursuant to and by authority of the following By-laws and Authorizations of The Ohio Casualty Insurance Company, Liberty Mutual Insurance Company, and West American Insurance Company which resolutions are now in full force and effect reading as follows:

ARTICLE IV – OFFICERS: Section 12. Power of Attorney.

Any officer or other official of the Corporation authorized for that purpose in writing by the Chairman or the President, and subject to such limitation as the Chairman or the President may prescribe, shall appoint such attorneys-in-fact, as may be necessary to act in behalf of the Corporation to make, execute, seal, acknowledge and deliver as surety any and all undertakings, bonds, recognizances and other surety obligations. Such attorneys-in-fact, subject to the limitations set forth in their respective powers of attorney, shall have full power to bind the Corporation by their signature and execution of any such instruments and to attach thereto the seal of the Corporation. When so executed, such instruments shall be as binding as if signed by the President and attested to by the Secretary. Any power or authority granted to any representative or attorney-in-fact under the provisions of this article may be revoked at any time by the Board, the Chairman, the President or by the officer or officers granting such power or authority.

ARTICLE XIII – Execution of Contracts: Section 5. Surety Bonds and Undertakings.

Any officer of the Company authorized for that purpose in writing by the chairman or the president, and subject to such limitations as the chairman or the president may prescribe, shall appoint such attorneys-in-fact, as may be necessary to act in behalf of the Company to make, execute, seal, acknowledge and deliver as surety any and all undertakings, bonds, recognizances and other surety obligations. Such attorneys-in-fact subject to the limitations set forth in their respective powers of attorney, shall have full power to bind the Company by their signature and execution of any such instruments and to attach thereto the seal of the Company. When so executed such instruments shall be as binding as if signed by the president and attested by the secretary.

Certificate of Designation – The President of the Company, acting pursuant to the Bylaws of the Company, authorizes David M. Carey, Assistant Secretary to appoint such attorneys-in-fact as may be necessary to act on behalf of the Company to make, execute, seal, acknowledge and deliver as surety any and all undertakings, bonds, recognizances and other surety obligations.

Authorization – By unanimous consent of the Company's Board of Directors, the Company consents that facsimile or mechanically reproduced signature of any assistant secretary of the Company, wherever appearing upon a certified copy of any power of attorney issued by the Company in connection with surety bonds, shall be valid and binding upon the Company with the same force and effect as though manually affixed.
