Dear Director Howland:

This submission provides responses to two outstanding Record Requests in the above-referenced docket. As to the first item, during the January 16, 2019 hearing in the instant proceeding, the Commission Staff referenced certain information relating to Eversource's Rate Reduction Bonds included on Bates page 12 of Exhibit 2. More particularly, as part of its request, the Staff asked whether Eversource had, and would provide, certain bank account information underlying the data displayed on that page. Eversource stated that it would provide the information, and the Commission held Exhibit 4 open for that information. Included with this letter is the information requested by Staff. Given the confidential nature of the banking information in Exhibit 4, also included with this submission is a motion for confidential treatment relating to that material. Eversource requests that the Commission accept this material as Exhibit 4 and grant the related motion for confidential treatment.

As to the second item, on January 17, 2019, the Commission submitted a post-hearing request for a revised version of Exhibits 2 and 3. The basis for the request was that during the hearing Eversource had provided information about the impact on the pending rate request from the inclusion the costs relating to the implementation of SB 365. Presently, Exhibits 2 and 3 include those costs. The Commission has requested that Eversource revise those exhibits to exclude the costs relating to SB 365 and submit those as Exhibit 5. Submitted with this letter are modified versions of Exhibits 2 and 3 removing the costs of SB 365. The amendments to the information in Exhibits 2 and 3 showing the changes from the prior versions have been highlighted or tracked for ready identification. Eversource requests that the Commission accept this material as Exhibit 5. Thank you for your assistance with this matter. Please do not hesitate to contact me with any questions.
