**Assented-To Motion to Withdraw Pillsbury Realty Development, LLC's Motion to Compel**

Pillsbury Realty Development, LLC ("Pillsbury") files this assented-to motion to withdraw Pillsbury's motion to compel and states:

1. On February 26, 2019, Pillsbury filed a motion to compel Pennichuck Water Works, Inc., Pennichuck East Utility, Inc., and Pittsfield Aqueduct Company, Inc. ("the Companies") to respond to certain data requests that Pillsbury timely propounded on the Companies in the above-captioned docket.
2. On March 7, 2019, the Companies objected to Pillsbury's motion to compel.
3. Pillsbury now moves to withdraw its motion to compel that is presently before the Commission. In light of Pillsbury's present motion to withdraw, no further action is required with respect to Pillsbury's motion to compel at this time. Withdrawal of Pillsbury's motion to compel will help promote the efficient and orderly conduct of the proceeding. Moreover, none of the parties will be prejudiced by the relief requested herein.
4. Pillsbury has sought and received the Companies' assent for the relief requested in this motion.

- B. Grant such other relief that is just.


