On January 22, 2019, Single Source Energy Solutions Inc. (Single Source) filed an application to register as a provider of natural gas aggregation service. Single Source's previous registration, which was approved under Docket DM 12-252, expired on October 31, 2017. On December 24, 2018 Staff requested Single Source pay an additional amount to cover the fee for an initial application, which Single Source submitted on January 22, 2019.

Commission Staff has reviewed the application and has determined that the filing is complete and the application meets the requirements for registration under N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3000. Staff therefore recommends approval of Single Source's application to register as a provider of natural gas aggregation service, effective on the date of the Commission's approval letter, for a term of 2 years.
