To the Parties:

On September 9, 2005, the Commission issued Order No. 24,511 in Docket No. DE 05-064, in which it approved Unitil Energy Systems, Inc.'s (Unitil) solicitation process for procuring default energy service for its G1 and Non-G1 customers. On September 27, 2019, Unitil filed a petition for approval of 100 percent of its default service power supply requirements for G1 and Non-G1 customers for the six-month period beginning December 1, 2019, as well as a proposed tariff incorporating the results of the solicitation in rates. In support of its petition, Unitil filed testimony and related exhibits of Jeffrey M. Pentz and Linda S. McNamara.

The Commission will hold a hearing on Wednesday, October 2, 2019 at 1:30 p.m., during which the Commission will hear the testimony of Mr. Pentz and Ms. McNamara. This is consistent with Order No. 24,511, in which the Commission stated on page 15 that "when Unitil presents its Supply Agreement and accompanying rates, we will review the rates pursuant to RSA 363:17-a."
