Please accept this Letter of Intent requesting additional numbering resources. Fox Valley Technical College requests 50 consecutive numbers in a specific range to integrate with the on premise PBX.

Fox Valley Technical College works with the National Criminal Justice Training Center. We have 10 locations in 3 states with our headquarters located in Appleton Wisconsin. Our New Hampshire location currently leases our phone numbers from the University of New Hampshire and are required to use the UNH phone system. We require the new numbers in order to combine our New Hampshire location to our national PBX.

Fox Valley Technical College recently completed a consolidation of four telecommunication service providers to AT&T SIP service paired with a new Mitel VoIP PBX. We are continuing to grow our national presence and would like to keep our four digit dialing plan. This is the reason for the extensive list of "must avoid" numbers detailed below. The Mitel system will also not allow for any extensions beginning with 0, 8, or 9. Fox Valley Technical College is hoping to activate these numbers prior to July 1, 2019. Given this is an expansion project we will not be returning our existing numbers.

Pending AT&T's successful completion of testing, Fox Valley Technical College understands these numbers will need to be activated within 180 days of the effective date. The 50 consecutive numbers will be B-VoIP service added to account number 8310008057455. The location the new numbers will be activated for is:

**Instructions for filling out each Section of the Part I A form:**

Section 1.1 Contact information requires that Service Providers supply under "Block Applicant" the company name, company headquarters address, a contact within the company, an address where the contact person may be reached, in addition to the correct phone, fax, and e-mail address. The Pooling Administrator section also requires the Service Provider to fill in the Pooling Administrator's name, address, phone, fax and e-mail.

Section 1.2 Service Providers who need a thousands-block assignment or for an Location Routing Number (LRN) are required to fill in this section. If needed for an LRN, a CO Code Application needs to also be submitted to the PA. The Service Provider should supply the Numbering Plan Area (NPA); the Local Access Transport Area (LATA), which is a three-digit number that can be found in the Telecordia Technologies, Inc. dba iconectiv (iconectiv™) LERG™ Routing Guide<sup>xi</sup>.
