With the proposed rate increase we will end up paying much higher fees even though we try to conserve.

The basic customer charge and automatic surcharges just add pain to the cold indoor temperatures we endure.

I urge the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission to reject the unfair Eversource rate proposals (DE 19-057).

New Hampshire is one the oldest states, by resident age, in the country. A lot of us are on fixed incomes and suffer the same way.

It will get to the point that we will have to move to another state just to keep warm.

Please reject the unfair Eversource residential rate hike proposals.
The 23.9% residential increase is just too much.
