Petition for Declaratory Ruling and Request for Mediation
Scheduling Technical Session and Granting Petition to Intervene of Town of Hudson

To the Parties:

On July 18, 2019, Commission Staff (Staff) filed a letter reporting the results of the July 17 technical session and requesting that an additional technical session be scheduled on July 25, 2019. The Commission scheduled the July 17 technical session by secretarial letter dated June 13, 2019, in order to provide the parties with an opportunity to resolve a procedural process dispute, namely, whether declaratory relief or some other process was appropriate in this matter.

Staff also stated in its July 18 letter that neither Pennichuck Water Works, Inc., nor Staff objected to the petition to intervene filed by the Town of Hudson (Hudson).

Accordingly, the Commission has scheduled a technical session¹ on Thursday, July 25, 2019, at 9:00 a.m. Further, the Commission has granted Hudson's petition to intervene, finding that the standard for intervention in RSA 541-A:32, I, has been met. N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 203.17.
