Suspension of Procedural Schedule

To the Parties:

On November 5, 2019, Commission Staff (Staff) filed a letter requesting an indefinite suspension of the procedural schedule that was approved in the above-captioned matter on July 16, 2019. Staff requested the suspension so that the parties would have time to fully consider Order No. 26,297 (October 8, 2019), which suspended the development of low-moderate income pilot programs for two years, and SB 165 (2019), known as the "Low-Income Community Solar Act of 2019," which was enacted, effective July 1, 2019. The letter stated that Staff would work with the parties to determine how to move forward in this docket and then file a report with the Commission. The parties assented to Staff's request.

Based on Staff's request, the Commission has suspended the procedural schedule for a period of six months, ending May 14, 2020. On or before May 14, 2020, Staff shall file a status report with the Commission.
