Petition for Recovery of Storm Expenses

Dear Director Howland:

On May 31, 2019 Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy (“Eversource”) submitted its petition for recovery of storm expenses pertaining to storm events from January to September 2018. On January 21, 2021 the Commission’s Staff recommended recovery of the requested storm expenses subject to certain disallowances. On March 23, 2021, the Commission issued a secretarial letter approving the amounts specified in the Staff’s recommendation. As part of its letter, the Commission also stated that “Eversource shall notify Staff when the Company has determined the amount of appropriate carrying charges, and it shall confirm the amount of the recovery and balance of the MSCR fund.” March 23, 2021 Secretarial Letter at 2.

By this letter, Eversource is informing the Commission that on May 10, 2021, Eversource notified the Staff of the carrying charges and confirmed the amount of the recovery and the balance of the MSCR fund and the Staff has confirmed that the information provided fulfills the Commission’s requirements. For clarity, the total amount of recovered costs is \$18,321,869 which reflects the balance of costs noted in the Commission’s letter as updated with the application of the appropriate carrying charges through March 2021.
