Dear Chairman Goldner:

This letter serves to update the report filed by Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy ("PSNH" or the "Company") on January 16. In that letter, the Company reported that the current Excess Cumulative Reduction Amount over the \$100 million cap for the period ending December 31, 2023, was \$70,902,064.86, and that the forecasted change in the Excess Cumulative Reduction Amount over the \$100 million cap through June 30, 2024 was \$59,070,751.34.

As the Commission knows, the company filed updated information in Docket No. DE 23-091 showing a revised June 30 estimate of the Excess Cumulative Reduction Amount of \$52,279,000, to reflect that in the event the sums owed by Burgess exceed the sums PSNH would otherwise pay to Burgess for a particular billing period, PSNH will net the amount owed against any other revenue including capacity and REC revenue available for that billing period.
