Re: DE 20-092, Request to Participate Remotely at Hearings Due to Exposure to COVID 19

Dear Chairman Goldner,

Hearings in DE 20-092, Electric and Gas Utilities, 2021-2023 Triennial Energy Efficiency Plan, are currently scheduled for April 21 & 22, 2022. In response to several parties' requests, on April 11, 2022, the Commission ordered that a hybrid hearing format be used for these hearings and directed any additional parties wishing to appear remotely at the hearings to file separate requests.

The undersigned, who represents Conservation Law Foundation ("CLF") in this matter, recently learned that he was in close contact on April 19, 2022, with someone in CLF's Concord, NH office that tested positive for COVID 19. Pursuant to CLF's policies (which follow CDC guidelines), CLF employees who are exposed to individuals testing positive for COVID 19 are expected to work at home for five days following exposure.

In order to avoid the possibility of exposing hearing participants in DE 20-092 to COVID 19 and to comply with CLF's COVID 19 policies, the undersigned respectfully requests that he be allowed to participate remotely for the scheduled hearings in the above-captioned docket.
