AFFIDAVIT OF NOTICE AND MAILING

NOW COMES David P. Montgomery, upon oath, being duly sworn, and states as follows:

1. I am the President of Dunbarton Telephone Company, Inc. (“DTC”), the petitioner in the above-captioned docket, which involves DTC’s request for approval of an emergency modification of the service territory boundary that it shares with Consolidated Communications of Northern New England, LLC d/b/a Consolidated Communications—NNE (“Consolidated”) in the Town of Dunbarton.

2. On July 13, 2020, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (“the Commission”) issued Order No. 26,380, an Order *Nisi* Approving Franchise Boundary Modification (the “Order”).

3. In the Order, the Commission directed DTC to take, *inter alia*, the following actions:

a. Cause a copy of the Order to be published on DTC’s website within one business day following the date of the Order, to be documented by affidavit filed with the Commission on or before July 20, 2020; and

b. Cause a copy of the Order to be delivered by first class mail to each affected property owner and to the Town Clerk of Dunbarton, New Hampshire, such delivery to be postmarked no later than July 16, 2020, and documented by affidavit filed with the Commission on or before July 20, 2020.

4. On behalf of DTC, I caused a copy of the Order to be published on DTC’s website on July 14, 2020, a true and accurate copy of such publication being attached here as **EXHIBIT “A”**.

5. On behalf of DTC, I caused a copy of the Order to be delivered by first class mail to each affected property owner and to the Town Clerk of Dunbarton, New Hampshire, on July 15, 2020, a complete list of the addressees being attached here as **EXHIBIT "B"**.

6. In each of the foregoing notices by publication or U.S. mail, the Order provided notice that persons interested in responding to the Order may submit comments or file a written request for a hearing, stating the reason and basis for such hearing, no later than July 27, 2020, for the Commission's consideration.
