Dear Mr. Phillips:

On July 17, 2020, you filed a letter, as counsel for the members of the New Hampshire Telephone Association (NHTA), requesting an extension of the July 24, 2020 deadline for incumbent local exchange carriers (ILECs) to file statements containing information relevant to the above-captioned matter. In your letter, you stated that the NHTA represents all ILECs currently operating in New Hampshire. On behalf of the NHTA, you have requested an extension of the deadline to July 31, 2020, stating that other regulatory matters and scheduled vacations prevent the ILECs from meeting as a group prior to July 23, 2020. Commission Staff has assented to your request.

The Commission has granted the NHTA's request for an extension. *See* N.H. Admin. R., Puc 202.04. Accordingly, the ILECs, either jointly or individually, shall file with the Commission a statement containing the information they believe to be relevant to this investigation on or before Friday, July 31, 2020.
