Electric Vehicle Time of Use Rates  
Amended Procedural Schedule

To the Parties:

On April 27, 2021, Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy (Eversource), with the support of Commission Staff (Staff), the Office of the Consumer Advocate, and every other party to the proceeding, requested the Commission amend the procedural schedule to reschedule the filing of the Electric Vehicle Time of Use Rates (EV TOU) and alternative metering feasibility assessment from April 30 to June 15, 2021, and reschedule the May 20, 2021 technical session to as soon as is practicable after June 15, 2021.

Eversource stated that, consistent with the Settlement Agreement in DE 19-057, the Company intends to file an updated residential time of day rate on June 15, 2021. Eversource asserts that it is in the midst of conducting analysis for its residential time of day rate filing that will substantially inform its EV TOU rate, and that a filing by the current April 30, 2021 deadline would need to be updated or supplemented as development of the residential time of day rate continues. Eversource further stated that the proposed procedural schedule amendment would optimize use of the parties' resources and not unduly delay this proceeding.

The Commission has determined that the proposed amended schedule is in the public interest and, therefore, has approved it. Accordingly, the EV TOU and alternative metering feasibility assessment filing deadline has been extended to June 15, 2021, and the May 20, 2021 technical session has been rescheduled to July 9, 2021 at 10:00 am.
