# **Electric Distribution Utilities Electric Vehicle Time of Use Rates**

### DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY MOTION FOR REMOTE PARTICIPATION

The Department of Energy (Department) respectfully moves the Public Utilities

Commission (Commission) pursuant to Puc 203.07 to allow for remote participation of Sanem I.

Sergici, of the Brattle Group, Inc., on behalf of the Department, who cannot appear in person during the hearing scheduled for January 31, 2023 in Docket No. DE 20-170.

In support of this motion, the Department states the following:

- On July 6, 2022, Public Service of New Hampshire Company d/b/a Eversource
  (Eversource) filed in Docket No. DE 20-170, as required by Order No. 26,204,
  proposals for a two-period time of use (TOU) rate for separately metered electric
  vehicle (EV) charging residential customers and a three-period TOU rate for
  separately metered EV charging commercial customers.
- 2. On October 7, 2022, Eversource filed an alternative metering feasibility assessment pilot program proposal (Pilot) in Docket No. DE 20-170, as required by Order No. 26,604.
- 3. On November 23, 2022, the Commission scheduled a hearing in Docket No. DE 20-170 to provide Eversource and the parties with an opportunity to address matters pertaining to Eversource's assumptions, design, and cost estimates for its proposed EV TOU tariff and its proposed EV metering Pilot.

4. The Department believes Ms. Sergici, who is based in Louisiana, should participate in

the hearing scheduled for January 31, 2023. Ms. Sergici previously filed testimony in

this docket regarding residential EV TOU rate designs and alternative rate design

proposals for high-demand draw public EV charging facilities, proposed by

Eversource.

5. As Ms. Sergici has not submitted pre-filed testimony for this hearing, the Department

is not sponsoring Ms. Sergici as a witness, however her expertise and previous

experience in this docket could provide the Commission with useful context during

the hearing, if necessary.

6. To allow for the participation of Ms. Sergici, and to avoid the expense of having her

travel to New Hampshire, the Department files this motion to request that she be

allowed to participate remotely.

WHEREFORE, the Department respectfully requests that the Commission:

(1) Allow Ms. Sergici to participate in the January 31, 2023, hearing remotely; and

(2) Order such further relief as may be just and equitable.
