Provide a description of whether Time-of-Use (TOU) rates are available or planned to be made available in other Eversource territories, including details on any associated timelines.

Response:

In both its Connecticut and Massachusetts service areas Eversource offers a number of residential and general service rates that include TOU components. These rates are available to provide service for all the customer's energy needs. At this time, there are no approved, EV-specific TOU rates in any of Eversource's service areas although, in Connecticut Eversource has filed with CT PURA a motion for approval of two EV TOU rates applicable to commercial EV charging, effective January 1, 2024. In Massachusetts, Eversource is in the process of developing a proposal for a residential EV TOU charging rate anticipated to be filed with the MA DPU in August 2023. This rate may also be available to small commercial customers. That proposal is still being designed and there is no implementation timeline at this time.
