Dear Chairman Goldner:

The Department of Energy (Department), with the concurrence of Liberty Utilities (Granite State Electric) Corp. d/b/a Liberty (Liberty) and the Office of the Consumer Advocate (OCA), hereby requests an extension to the approved procedural schedule in this matter, pursuant to Puc 202.04.

By procedural order dated March 4, 2022 in this proceeding, the Commission approved the schedule set forth below under the column "Current Date" including setting August 16, 2022 as the date by which written testimony of the Department and OCA is to be submitted.¹ Due to significant workload in many other Commission dockets this summer involving overlapping Department staff (regulatory and legal), long standing (prepaid/non-refundable) summer vacation plans, and the recently adjusted procedural schedule in the Eversource Energy LCIRP docket (DE 20-161)², the Department seeks an additional month to prepare its testimony in this case. This will also provide the Department additional time to review the considerable number of record responses expected from Liberty in this case on August 5, 2022 and to structure its testimony accordingly. Absent an extension, the Department's testimony will need to be significantly abbreviated or possibly foregone.

If the testimony date is changed, other dates would need to be extended as well and thus the Department proposes the following schedule adjustments:
