Assented-to Motion to Amend Procedural Schedule

Liberty Utilities (Granite State Electric). d/b/a Liberty (Company), through counsel, respectfully moves the Commission to amend the procedural schedule in this docket to suspend the February 18, 2022, deadline for the Company to file its Non-Wires Solution (NWS) proposal. In support of this motion, Liberty represents as follows:

- The procedural schedule in this docket calls for the Company to file its NWS
 proposal by February 18, 2022. The NWS proposal is a component of the Company's Least
 Cost Integrated Resource Plan (LCIRP) that is before the Commission for its review in this
 docket.
- The Company is in the process of reassessing its NWS with respect to planning criteria, reliability, and how this project compares to traditional options in light of changing market dynamics.
- 3. Since it is difficult to estimate the time necessary to conduct the reassessment and update or amend the NWS proposal, the Company requests suspension of only the February 18, 2022, deadline.

4. The Company will engage the parties to this proceeding regarding the NWS

proposal on an ongoing basis and, with their input, determine an appropriate deadline for

its filing.

5. The Company does not request a change to any other dates in the procedural

schedule. The parties may continue to conduct their review of all other aspects of the

LCIRP.

6. The Company asked the parties to this docket for their position on this request to

postpone the filing date for the NWS proposal. Both the Department of Energy and the

Office of the Consumer Advocate indicated that they do not object. No other party has

sought to intervene.

WHEREFORE, Liberty respectfully asks the Commission to:

a. Grant this motion and suspend the February 18, 2022, deadline for the Company to

file its NWS proposal;

b. Grant any further relief deemed just and proper.
