Please accept this comment on Liberty's request for additional gas capacity contracts for NH customers via DG 21-008.

As a resident of NH and a ratepayer, I am concerned with Liberty Utilities' business practices and their continued focus on expanding fracked methane gas usage in New Hampshire. The climate crisis is getting worse every year and the investment in fossil fuels is unethical at this point. New Hampshire lags behind in renewable energy use and energy efficiency in particular, and Liberty's money would be better spent making a difference on those fronts. Ratepayers are going to be paying more for energy this winter, and bringing in more fracked methane gas is not a solution that will decrease our energy bills in the long run.
