Supplement to Staff Recommendation

This is a supplement to the memorandum filed on January 27, 2021. On January 22, 2021, Titan Energy New England (Titan) filed an application to renew its registration as a provider of natural gas aggregation service. Titan's most recent registration was approved to run through January 11, 2021. Staff notes that, pursuant to N.H. Admin. R., Puc 3003.06(a), Titan's renewal application should have been filed at least 60 days prior to the expiration of its currently-effective registration, on or before November 12, 2020. Staff recommends that a waiver of Puc 3003.06(a) be granted and that Puc 3003.06(h) also be waived to permit Titan's renewed registration to be effective as of January 11, 2021.

Staff reviewed Titan's application and determined that the filing is complete and the application meets the requirements for registration under N.H. Admin. R., Puc 3000. Staff therefore reiterates its recommendation that Titan's application to renew its registration as a provider of natural gas aggregation service be approved, effective as of January 11, 2021, for a term of two years.
