On April 2, 2021, the Commission held a duly noticed prehearing conference in the above-referenced matter. Appearances were entered by Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy and Consolidated Communications of Northern New England Company, LLC d/b/a Consolidated Communications (collectively, the Petitioners), the Office of the Consumer Advocate (OCA), and Commission Staff (Staff). The Commission granted the petition to intervene filed by New England Cable and Telecommunications Association, Inc. (NECTA).

Staff shall report the outcome of this discussion to the Commission on or before April 30, 2021.
