This will serve as a second follow-up to the Commission Staff's report of Friday, April 30, 2021, in the above captioned docket regarding the Joint Petitioners' Motion for Protective Order and Confidential Treatment of the Settlement and Pole Asset Purchase Agreement. Attached for filing with the Commission are the: (i) partially redacted Exhibit A (Bill of Sale) and (ii) unredacted Exhibit B (Assignment of Attachment Agreements) to the Joint Petitioners' Settlement and Pole Purchase Agreement, the lesser redacted version of which I filed on Monday, May 3.

In addition, on behalf of our respective clients, Attorney Susan Geiger and I have worked out an agreeable arrangement related to the disclosure of confidential information in this Docket to NECTA's representatives and certain representatives of NECTA's members. Eversource assents to the arrangement. The parties will prepare and will file for Commission approval a Motion for Approval of Protective Agreement and the related Protective Agreement. Pending Commission approval of same, the NECTA participants will be granted access to the confidential information upon execution of the Protective Agreement.
