**Joint Petition to Approve Pole Asset Transfer**

**Procedural Order Re: Assented-to Motion to Adjust Procedural Schedule**

The Commission issued a procedural order on November 19, 2021, which amended the procedural schedule and established a February 22, 2022 deadline for a settlement conference and rebuttal testimony. On February 18, 2022, Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy and Consolidated Communications of Northern New England Company, LLC d/b/a Consolidated Communications (together, the Movants) filed a motion to change this deadline to require the filing of rebuttal testimony by February 25, 2022, with a settlement conference to be held no later than Wednesday, March 2, 2022. The Movants stated that this adjustment to the procedural schedule would allow the remaining parties, New England Cable and Telecommunications Association, Inc. (NECTA), the Office of the Consumer Advocate (OCA), and the New Hampshire Department of Energy (Energy), an opportunity to evaluate the Movants' rebuttal testimony prior to the settlement conference. The Movants represented that NECTA, OCA, and Energy assented to their motion.

The Movants' Assented-to Motion to Adjust Procedural Schedule is GRANTED. The procedural schedule contained in the November 19 procedural order is amended as follows:

Rebuttal Testimony Due	February 25, 2022
Settlement Conference	No later than March 2, 2022

The settlement conference will be not be scheduled on the Commission's hearings calendar, but will be conducted on a date and at a time and location agreed to by the parties. The hearing on the merits remains scheduled on Tuesday, March 15, 2022, from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. It will be conducted in person in accordance with the hearing guidelines letter dated November 19, 2022.
