Dear Chairwoman Martin:

On behalf of Pennichuck Water Works, Inc., please find the original of the quarterly update for the 2021 QCPAC Petition of Pennichuck Water Works, Inc. A copy will also be filed electronically. To highlight the update, the Supply Pond Dam and Harris Dam work will not be occurring in 2021 due to reclassification of Bowers Dam as a high hazard which will require rebuild of the Bowers Dam. This will eliminate most of the work required for the Supply Pond Dam and reduce the scope of work for the Harris Dam. The combined dam work will not be completed until 2022; therefore, PWW will not seek reimbursement in the 2021 PWW QCPAC for this work. Deferment of this work and associated funds will be re-allocated to a number of ongoing sewer replacement projects in 2021.
