Dear Chairman Goldner:

Pennichuck Water Works, Inc., (PWW) in conjunction with the New Hampshire Department of Energy (Department) have developed a proposed procedural schedule in the above-referenced matter in compliance with the Commission's Procedural Order dated December 3, 2021. In order to allow time for the completion of a settlement between the Company and the Department in this case, the parties propose the filing a Settlement Agreement for the Commission's consideration by January 28, 2022. The procedural order requested that the schedule provide for a hearing on the merits; however, previously the Commission has ruled on the annual QCPAC surcharge by Order Nisi¹. If, after the submission of the proposed Settlement Agreement on January 28, 2022, the Commission decides not to issue an Order Nisi approving the proposed surcharge, then PWW and the Department respectfully request that the Commission adopt the following proposed procedural schedule which provides for the filing of a Settlement Agreement, and a hearing on the merits of the settlement. There are no intervenors or other participants in this docket at this time.
