Dear Director Howland:

Pursuant to Section 9 of the October 9, 2020 settlement agreement (the "Settlement") on permanent rates which was approved by Order No. 25,433 on December 15, 2020 in Docket No. DE 19-057, by March 1 of each year Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy ("Eversource" or the "Company") is to submit a filing containing reports its reliability statistics and vegetation management activities, and request the Commission open a new docket to consider the filing and other issues as part of the Regulatory Reconciliation Adjustment ("RRA"). Thereafter, on or by May 1 of each year, the Company is to update its RRA filing with information pertaining to all other components of the RRA filing, along with supporting testimony and exhibits for rates effective August 1 of that year.

On March 1, 2021, the Company submitted a petition along with the testimony and supporting information of Lee G. Lajoie and Robert D. Allen, providing the relevant information and explanations of the Company's reliability performance and vegetation management activities in calendar year 2020. By this filing, the Company is now providing the materials and support for the remaining segments of the RRA as contemplated in Section 9 of the Settlement.

Enclosed with this submission is the testimony and supporting information of Erica L. Menard and Jennifer A. Ullram providing the relevant information supporting the proposed change to the RRA for effect on August 1, 2021. Additionally, this submission includes the separate testimony and supporting information of Jennifer A. Ullram providing information pertaining to the Company's calculation of lost base revenue due to net metering, which is included in the overall RRA calculation. Consistent with the petition submitted on March 1, 2021 in this proceeding, Eversource requests that the Commission include this information in its review and that it consider these matters in a manner that will permit the Commission to issue a decision in time for adjusted rates to be effective as of August 1 as provided in the Settlement.
