Dear Chairwoman Martin:

On behalf of Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. ("UES"), enclosed is a corrected electronic copy of "UES Annual Major Storm Cost Reserve Fund Report" for the 12 month period ending December 31, 2020. The corrected copy is provided in both "clean" and "redlined" versions to show where the correction occurs. The originally filed MSCR inadvertently stated Tropical Storm Isaias costs of \$75,466.65, which included a Matter Communications (formerly Calypso) of \$2,436.90. The actual amount of storm costs for recovery should have been **\$73,029.75** and a resulting MSCR balance as of December 31, 2020 of **\$3,244,348.48**.
