In addition to the above referenced tariff pages, the approved change to UES's Default Service Charge [Non-G1 Class] also impacts the discounts provided on tariff page 6, Summary of Low-Income Electric Assistance Program Discounts. As part of its original filing in DE 21-041, UES did not include this tariff page as it was waiting for approval of changes pending in DE 18-036, for effect May 1, 2021, which will affect the Summary of Low-Income Electric Assistance Program Discounts. Furthermore, UES also has June 1, 2021 rate changes pending as part of DE 21-030 (the temporary rate increase request pursuant to RSA 378:27), which will also affect the Summary of Low-Income Electric Assistance Program Discounts. UES will file this tariff page, Summary of Low-Income Electric Assistance Program Discounts, upon approval of pending rates in the appropriate dockets.
