Dear Ms. Howland:

In compliance with Order No. 26,475 (Apr. 30, 2021), enclosed is a confidential version and a redacted version of the amended CNG Master Agreement signed by Liberty and XNG on June 2, 2021, to be effective July 1, 2021 ("Amended Agreement"). In accordance with the Order, Liberty asserts that the Amended Agreement is consistent with applicable rules and laws. Staff has confirmed that the Amended Agreement resolves Staff's stated concerns that the January version of the Master Agreement was inconsistent with Liberty's CNG facility operating procedures and emergency management procedures and is not inconsistent with NHPUC 506.01.

Also enclosed is an affidavit of a Liberty employee confirming the physical location of certain aspects of the CNG facility that are defined in the Amended Agreement. Debra A. Howland June 10, 2021

The Order stated that "the Commission may hold an additional hearing, if necessary," on the CNG Master Agreement, to be effective July 1, 2020. Note that the Liberty, Staff and the OCA do not request such a hearing.

Last, although referenced in my prior letter, the parties do not intend to file a settlement agreement.
