Notice of Intent to File Rate Schedules (Puc 1604.05)

Dear Director Howland:

Please accept this letter on behalf of Northern Utilities, Inc. (the "Company"), in accordance with the New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules, Section 1604.05, as its Notice of Intent to File Rate Schedules pursuant to RSA Ch. 378. The Company will be seeking an increase in base rates of approximately \$7.7 million, based on a proforma 2020 Test Year, and a rate plan for the annual recovery, beginning in 2022, of the costs associated with certain plant additions. The Company's proposed base rate increase will result in a total revenue increase of 10.7 percent including changes in existing reconciling mechanisms. The Company also intends to file rate schedules requesting temporary rates, pursuant to RSA 378:27, during the pendency of the permanent rate relief request.
