Dear Chairwoman Martin:

Enclosed please find a Stipulation and Settlement Regarding Temporary Rates signed by Northern Utilities, Inc. (“Unitil”), the Department of Energy, and the Office of the Consumer Advocate in the above-referenced matter. The Settlement allows for a total annual temporary distribution service revenue level of \$2,599,083 above the current revenue level. The increase to distribution service rates shall be effective with service rendered on and after October 1, 2021.

Unitil respectfully requests that the Commission schedule a hearing on this Stipulation and Settlement as soon as practicable to allow for consideration of and deliberation on the agreement in advance of the requested October 1, 2021 effective date.
