RE: DG 21-104, Assented-To Motion to Cancel Rebuttal Deadline

Dear Chairman Goldner:

In connection with the above-referenced docket, enclosed is an Assented-To Motion to cancel (without prejudice) the deadline to file rebuttal testimony in this docket.

On May 5 and 6, 2022, Northern Utilities, Inc. ("Unitil"), the Department of Energy ("DOE"), and the Office of the Consumer Advocate ("OCA") (collectively, the "Joint Parties") engaged in settlement discussions pursuant to the procedural schedule. The discussions were productive, and the Joint Parties reached a comprehensive agreement in principle and are in the process of memorializing the settlement. Accordingly, Unitil requests that the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission amend the procedural schedule to cancel the deadline for the submission of rebuttal testimony. In that an agreement has been reached as discussed, there is no longer a need for rebuttal testimony. The Company will instead focus its resources on drafting and finalizing a written Settlement Agreement with the other Joint Parties.

The DOE and OCA have assented to the relief requested in the enclosed motion.
