## RE: DG 21-104: Motion to Cancel June 2, 2022 Hearing Date

Chairman Goldner:

In connection with the above-referenced docket I enclose a Motion to cancel the June 2, 2022 hearing date in this docket..

Unitil, the Department of Energy, and the Office of the Consumer Advocate had engaged in productive settlement discussions and reached a comprehensive agreement in principle, and were in the process of memorializing the settlement. Unitil anticipates that the settling parties will submit a finalized Settlement Agreement for the Commission's consideration in the next several days.

Unitil requests, in the enclosed motion, that the Commission <u>cancel the hearing date</u> presently scheduled for June 2 and schedule a hearing on the Settlement Agreement for <u>either June 7 or June 8</u>, days that are already set aside on the Commission's calendar for rate case hearings. This will enable the Company to submit the Settlement Agreement in compliance with Puc 203.20(e) and provide the Commission with sufficient time to review the Settlement Agreement prior to the hearing.
