Re: DW 21-115 Pennichuck Water Works, Inc.-Anheuser Busch Special Contract Revisions to Cost to Service

## Dear Chairwoman Martin:

This proceeding commenced on June 4, 2021 with the filing by Pennichuck Water Works, Inc. (PWW) of a new proposed special contract with one of PWW's largest users, Anheuser-Busch, LLC. That proposed special contract was based on a cost of service study. That cost of service study has since been revised in light of new data. That new data is that surrounding communities are now seeking to revise their existing special contracts with PWW to address groundwater contamination of their water sources. Discussions with those communities is ongoing and has not yet produced filings for the Commission's review.

The net result of the expected changes to these other community special contracts is that they change the costs borne by Anheuser-Busch, LLC. Therefore, PWW will be revising its filing originally submitted for Commission review. PWW expects to have these revisions completed and filed with the Commission within the next two weeks. This correspondence is to alert the Commission of this pending revision to its Anheuser-Busch, LLC filing.
