Re: DG 21-130; Liberty Utilities (EnergyNorth Natural Gas) Corp. d/b/a Liberty Winter 2021-2022 Cost of Gas — February 2022 Monthly Cost of Gas Adjustment

On behalf of Liberty Utilities (EnergyNorth Natural Gas) Corp. d/b/a Liberty (the "Company") and in accordance with New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (the "Commission") Order No. 26,541 (October 29, 2021) in Docket No. DG 21-130, I enclose for filing the Company's (February) calculation of its projected collection of gas costs for the 2021–2022 Winter season ending April 30, 2022.

The calculation reflects the estimated January 2022 through April 2022 NYMEX settled forward prices as of January 21, 2022. The resulting projected over collection of approximately \$5,903,548 is 7.9% of the total revised anticipated gas costs for the 2021–2022 winter season.

The calculated cost of gas rate is \$0.5956 per therm. The company elects to reduce the cost of gas rate effective February 1, 2022. The current and revised cost of gas rates are listed in the table below.
