## Re: DG 21-130; Liberty Utilities (EnergyNorth Natural Gas) Corp. d/b/a Liberty Summer 2022 Cost of Gas — October 2022 Monthly Cost of Gas Adjustment

On behalf of Liberty Utilities (EnergyNorth Natural Gas) Corp. d/b/a Liberty (the "Company") and in accordance with Commission Order No. 26,449 (July 15, 2022) in Docket No. DG 21-130, I enclose for filing the Company's (October) calculation of its projected collection of gas costs for the 2022 summer season ending October 31, 2022.

The calculation reflects the estimated September 2022 through October 2022 NYMEX settled forward prices as of September 20, 2022. The resulting projected under-collection of approximately \$11,143,419 is 43.93% of the total revised anticipated gas costs for the 2022 summer season.

The calculated cost of gas rate is \$2.7558 per therm. The Company is at the maximum allowed cost of gas rate and will not be changing rates effective October 1, 2022.
