## Winter 2021-2022 Cost of Gas — February 2022 Monthly COG Adjustment

On behalf of Liberty Utilities (EnergyNorth Natural Gas) Corp. d/b/a Liberty—Keene Division (the "Company") and in accordance with New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (the "Commission") Order No. 26,542 (October 29, 2021) in Docket No. DG 21-132, I enclose for filing the Company's (February) calculation of its projected collection of gas costs for the 2021-2022 Winter season ending April 30, 2022. The Company has marked certain third-party pricing information as confidential pursuant to Puc 201.06(a)(11). The Company is including a redlined copy of only the confidential version as the redacted version would not show redlines as the figures have been redacted.

The calculation reflects the estimated January 2022 NYMEX settled forward prices as of January 20, 2022. The resulting projected under collection of approximately \$70,274 is 4.2% of the total revised anticipated gas costs for the 2021–2022 winter season.

Liberty elects to implement a rate increase of \$0.1403 for the February 1, 2022, billing cycle. The current Cost of Gas rates are listed in the table below.
