**Petition for Approval of Emergency Temporary Water Rate**

**Procedural Order Re: Request for Remote Participation**

On November 2, 2021, Pennichuck Water Works, Inc. (PWW) filed a request for the following witness to appear remotely at the hearing scheduled on November 8, 2021, because he will be out of state:

PWW appeared to request that other PWW witnesses be permitted to participate remotely in the November 8 hearing due to health concerns related to the pandemic, but did not identify these witnesses. To the extent that New Hampshire Administrative Rule Puc 203.07(e) provides 10 days for objections, it is hereby waived. Good reason for a hybrid hearing format has been provided with regard to Mr. Ware's, and other PWW witnesses', remote participation. 
